

### Micro Burial Bunting

(7 1/2 inches when done for 9 ounces and smaller )

( You can make a hat or bonnet)

Materials: Baby soft yarns, Choose your own color, Small ribbon to keep closed.

Size 5 straight needle, Yarn needle .

CO 40 Sts

(starting at bottom)

Knit 2 rows

Eyelet Row

K2 tog, YO, across [NOTE: do not drop your YO]

Row 1: K3, purl across, K3

Row 2: Knit across

Row 3: Repeat row 1

\*Repeat rows 2-3 (14 Rows that\*s 7 ridges/guarder sts on side)

When you have 7 ridges on the knit side

You -K1, YO, K2 tog, Knit across until last 3 sts, K2 tog, YO, K1.\*

Repeat [\*] 3 tomes altogether (total)

Then repeat row 3

Do Eyelet Row once more

Repeat row 3

Bind off all Stitches. Weave ribbon in top eyelet row & bottom eyelet row.

And the YO holes on ridges.

My micro preemie hat

CO 32 sts.

\*K1, P1\* [single rib] across

For 1 \*inch

Then Knit one row, Purl one row (stockinet Stitch)

For 2 \* inches

K2 tog across

On a purl side cut off yarn 12 inches long weave through loops on needle

Then take yarn off needle, pull up tight. Sew up side of hat.

(OPTIONAL) you can add pom, pom.
